ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 0223, dated 20.08.2015, under Sections 395 and 341 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Line Par, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that six persons with covered faces had looted a sum of Rs.1,60,000/- from the bank. He contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and has been arrayed as an accused in the disclosure statement of co-accused. He also contends that all the co-accused had been acquitted at the conclusion of the trial but the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court as he was not served at his address where he was living and had been declared as proclaimed offender. He, later on, was arrested and is in custody since 18.09.2018. He is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Subhash Chand states that 01 out of 18 prosecution witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for over 08 months; he is not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
