MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner/complainant has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions seeking protection of life and liberty as they are facing threat at hands of private respondents who are yet to be arrested in FIR No.250 dated 17.10.2018 under Sections 448 and 380 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar. It is further prayed that the directions be issued that the accused be arrested in the said FIR. Besides the prayer for restraining the official respondents from pressurizing her to compromise the matter is also made.

It is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners that the private respondents who are brother and sister-in-law, respectively of the complainant/petitioner, have been extended the concession of interim pre-arrest bail vide order dated 29.04.2019 through CRM-M-19060-2019.

In view of the above, present petition for issuance of directions for arrest of private respondents is rendered infructuous. As far as other part of the prayer is concerned, there is no convincing material placed on record to substantiate the allegations of alleged compulsion for entering into a compromise.

Therefore, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
