AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 30.04.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.10617 of 2018.

The only controversy in the present contempt petition is that as per directions contained in order dated 30.04.2018 of this Court, the claim of the petitioners has not been reconsidered by the Designated Committee.

Learned counsel for the respondent-bank states that reconsideration was not possible as three notices sent to the petitioners were received back with the report that the petitioners

have shifted from the given address. He further states that in case petitioner-Proprietor appears before the respondent-bank, the decision would be taken within four weeks thereafter. He submits that correct address of the petitioner may also be furnished for future communication.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that if a date is fixed, petitioner will appear before the respondent-bank and will also furnish the latest address.

Let petitioner-Proprietor appear before the respondent-bank on 26.09.2019 at 11:00 A.M. at Circle Office, Kurukshetra and decision shall be taken by the respondent-bank within four weeks thereafter.

The contempt petition is disposed of.
