The petition was filed by the petitioner for transfer of investigation in case FIR No.440 dated 03.09.2017 registered under Sections 323, 324, 336, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City to an independent agency.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh has apprised the Court that after conclusion of the investigation, final report already stands submitted before the competent Court. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and complainant. Since the investigation is complete, therefore, it will not be appropriate for this Court to order transfer of investigation in case FIR No.440 dated 03.09.2017 registered under Sections 323, 324, 336, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code. However, the issues raised

in the present petition can be raised by the petitioner before the Court at the time when the final report submitted is examined by the Court.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
