The contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner were recorded in detail in the order dated 07.05.2019 and learned counsel for the respondents had sought time to seek instructions on the same. When the matter is taken up today, learned counsel for respondent-PSPCL submits that recommendations of the then Member, Finance and Accounts and Member, Administration, as accepted by erstwhile PSEB, contained at Annexure P-32, would be implemented qua the petitioner, provided he fulfills the parameters laid therein.

2. In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass a speaking order by considering the case of petitioner in terms of the recommendations as contained in Annexure P-32.

3. It is expected of the respondents to take a decision with regard to claim of the petitioner by keeping in view the date of retirement of his junior and pass the order qua his case accordingly.
