This application is filed for placing on record compromise arrived at between the parties.

Application is allowed and the compromise arrived at between the parties is taken on record.

Main Case

Respondent-complainant is present in Court, who states that indeed compromise is effected between the parties and a copy of compromise is placed on record as Annexure P-1 and the entire cheque amount is received by him. The statement is also supported by an affidavit

of complainant filed in Court today which is taken on record. According to him, he is not opposing the prayer on behalf of the convict for compounding of the offence.

In view of the above, the prayer for compounding the offence is allowed. Impugned judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 26.10.2019 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkkotla and the order of the Appellate Court, Sangrur dated 03.12.2018 are set aside. The complainant is declared as inconsequential.
