This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.810 dated 17.10.2018 registered under Sections 384/34 IPC at Police Station Sector 7, Faridabad.

The allegations against the petitioner are that she honey trapped the complainant.

Counsel for the petitioner states that actually the fact of the matter is that the complainant had raped the petitioner and a case under Section 376 IPC is pending against him.

Counsel for the complainant has reiterated that a fake case was registered against his client and actually the petitioner is a part of a gang of extortionists.

I inquired whether the complainant was arrested in that case counsel for the complainant states that the complainant is on interim bail in that case.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would not oppose the confirmation of interim bail of the complainant.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Samunder Singh has accepted these factual assertions.

Be that as it may and keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
