GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.024, dated 12.4.2018, registered at Police Station Kot Fatta, District Bathinda, under Section 420 IPC.
2. The allegations, in nutshell, are that complainant Baljit Kaur was duped for an amount of ₹ 1,13,000/- on the pretext that she would be sent to Dubai and where she would get salary of ₹ 50-55,000/- per month whereas in fact she was sent to Oman where she was forced to do household work.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in fact the parties have entered into a compromise (Annexure P-1) and that the complainant has no objection for quashing of the FIR. It has also been informed that co-accused Rajesh Kumar has already been granted bail in view of the compromise.
4. The aforesaid position is not disputed by learned State counsel. It has also been informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court on 22.2.2019, the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation, as has been informed by learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh.
5. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the parties are stated to have compromised the matter and the petitioner has already joined investigation, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. The petition, as such, is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 22.2.2019 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
6. The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
