The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of directions so as to provide security and protection to them as they apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Notice of motion had been issued in this case.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Joginder Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, District Kaithal on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed by learned State counsel today in Court, which is taken on record.

It has been stated in the aforesaid reply that the statements of the petitioners namely Sandeep Kumar and Pooja have been recorded to the effect that they do not apprehend any threat to their life.

A perusal of the copies of the statements annexed with the said affidavit indicates that infact the petitioners have already parted ways and petitioner No.2 Pooja is residing with her parents and a petition for divorce by mutual consent has already been filed.

In view of the aforestated position, it is apparent that there is no threat perception to the petitioners. The petition, as such, is dismissed.
