By way of this writ petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to the Food Corporation of India to promote him to the post of Assistant Manager (Quality Control) with all consequential benefits w.e.f. 24.09.1991.

Perusal of the record reflects that the date of birth of the petitioner is 08.10.1947. He would therefore have retired from service long ago upon attaining the age of superannuation. The cause in this writ petition may not survive for consideration on merits in such circumstances. That is perhaps the reason why there is no representation for the petitioner or his learned counsel, when the matter is taken up for hearing.

In any event, as the petitioner is not showing any interest in pursuing this case, the writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
