Prayer is for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.0177 dated 10.08.2018 registered under Sections 18/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Nakodar Sadar, District Jalandhar.

As per the FIR, from two accused, who were travelling in a Swift car, 5.2 Kg opium was recovered. On conclusion of the investigation, the police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed and the trial Court has already started recording evidence.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner. However, learned trial Court is requested to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within a period of 6 months.

Disposed of, accordingly.
