The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Inderjit Singh in case FIR No.165 dated 29.12.2018, registered for the offence punishable under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur.

The allegation levelled against the petitioner is that he was harassing the deceased. Apart from it, compromise has also been effected.

It has been argued that liability of the petitioner qua offence under Section 306 IPC is debatable. Co-accused Resham Singh has already been granted the benefit of regular bail by this court vide order dated 20.02.2019 passed in CRM-M-6671-2019. Petitioner is in custody since 30.12.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on

regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
