Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as well as their family members at the hands of respondent Nos. 3 to 6 and not to involve in FIR No. 237 dated 05.11.2018, registered under Sections 451, 427, 506 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

Separate replies, filed by way of affidavit of the DSP, Sub Division City, Hoshiarpur as well as by way of affidavit of Inspector/SHO, Model Town, Hoshiarpur, are on record.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of the aforesaid replies and on instructions of ASI Raj Singh, has stated that the complaints/representations given by the petitioner were duly inquired into and they have been filed and both the petitioners were nominated as accused in the aforesaid FIR on the basis of supplementary statement made by the

complainant and on the basis of incriminating evidence which has come against them during investigation. Respondent Nos. 3 and 4, in their affidavit, have refuted the allegations of misbehaviour against the petitioners.

In view of the same, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
