This application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for
impleading Rajneesh Arora, r/o H.No.10-B, Model Town, Yamuna Nagar,
Haryana/complainant as respondent No.3.

For the reasons recorded, the application is allowed and the
amended memo of parties is taken on record. Complainant is impleaded as
respondent No.3.

Main Case

This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.31 dated 14.03.2018 registered under Sections 420/454/120-B IPC at Police Station North, Chandigarh.

It is agreed that further amount of Rs.3.90 crores has been handed over by the petitioner to the respondent No.3 on 24.12.2018 and with this the petitioner has returned the entire amount for the house in question as fixed by this Court.

Counsel appearing for respondent No.3 has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 24.04.2018 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
