Vide order dated 12.02.2019 passed by the Division Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, petitioner No.1 Dalbir Singh has been granted furlough from 14.3.2019 to 2.7.2019 and petitioner No.2 Satish from 29.3.2019 to 11.4.2019.

The limited prayer of the petitioners in the present petition is that they both be released on furlough w.e.f. 23.02.2019 instead of 14.3.2019 and 29.3.2019. This will enable them to attend the marriage of their nephew and niece which are to be solemnized on 23.02.2019.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ramesh Kumar Ambavta, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. In view of the urgency of the case, no formal reply is being called for.

The documents Annexure P-1 (Colly) show that the Divisional Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar – respondent No.2 has accepted the request of the petitioners for their release on furlough.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is allowed. The furlough period of petitioner No.1 Dalbir Singh is re-scheduled from '14.03.2019 to 27.03.2019' to '23.02.2019 to 08.03.2019' and that of petitioner No.2 Satish is re-scheduled from '29.03.2019 to 11.04.2019' to '23.02.2019 to 08.03.2019'.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
