The petitioner-plaintiff is aggrieved with the impugned order dated 30.01.2019 passed by the Ld. Civil Judge (Junior Division), Jhajjar. Vide the said order, the petitioner's application for interim injunction against the defendants-respondents from raising further construction over the suit property was declined. It may be mentioned that the impugned order was passed when interim relief had been sought for, even before reply to the pending injunction application, had been filed on behalf of the defendants-respondents.

2. Admittedly, the possession is with the respondents. The Ld. Court in the circumstances, was justified in declining the interim relief sought for by the petitioner. This Court finds no ground to interfere with the said order. The revision petition is, therefore, dismissed, however, with an observation that in the event of the proceedings being finally decided in favour of the petitioner-plaintiff, the respondents-defendants would be required to remove the constructions so raised at his own costs.
