This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.140 dated 23.7.2015 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.-7, District Ludhiana City.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition and states that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail before the court below and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail application expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It

is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the court on or before 15.03.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided on merits expeditiously but in any case by 18.03.2019.

Since the main case has been dismissed as withdrawn, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
