This petition has been hanging fire for the past two years where the petitioner is on interim bail. Admittedly, he has joined the investigation. Admittedly, on various occasions the matter has been referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre. Admittedly, the complainant has filed a civil suit for recovery of the amount. Both the parties claim to have in their possession signed documents from each other.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Chinder Pal Singh has accepted these facts.

In these convoluted circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 15.05.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
