The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case DDR/Report No.23, dated 7.8.2012 lodged under Sections 326, 324, 148, 149 of the IPC in FIR No.155, dated 9.6.2012, registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149, 326 of the IPC at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that similarly situated co-accused was granted anticipatory bail vide order passed in ***CRM-M-43081 of 2018*** dated 31.01.2019 (Annexure P-9).

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from HC Tarsem Singh has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, I see no reason to take a different view for the petitioner and consequently, grant him the concession of anticipatory bail in the same terms as in the above mentioned case.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
