Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu, Sr. DAG Punjab accepts notice. Counsel for the petitioners has supplied a copy of the paper book to learned Sr. DAG Punjab.

Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C, is for the issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondent Nos.4 to 10.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age, petitioner No.1 has placed on record her affidavit (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 13.8.1999. Petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of his Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) wherein his date of

birth is mentioned as 24.12.1996. They have also moved a representation before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar (respondent No.2) to take an appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
