The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking direction to the respondents to count service period rendered by her w.e.f. 12.10.1979 to 31.12.1990 on ad-hoc basis towards seniority, promotion and other consequential benefits along-with interest @24%. The petition was disposed of on 28.08.2018 without advertng on the merits of the case, directing the Director, Higher Education, Haryana to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the application/representation-P-2 (annexed with the writ petition). It was further ordered that in case the petitioner is aggrieved of the order, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law including approaching this Court.

The present petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of the directions of this Court.

Learned State counsel has placed on record a copy of order dated 06.12.2019, whereby, the claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner has been illegally rejected.

The said aspect cannot be gone into in the contempt proceedings. The direction of this Court was only to decide the representation and the same has been complied with.

The petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

Petitioner has already been granted the liberty by the writ Court to avail remedies if grievance survives.
