INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this third petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.994 dated 24.09.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 324 and 307 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Karnal.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per prosecution version, present petitioner Charanjeet alias Gindu was armed with knife and gave two injuries on the person of complainant-injured Gurnam. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended

that complainant-injured has been examined before the trial Court as PW-2

and he has not supported the prosecution version and turned hostile. The copy of the statement of complainant has also been placed on record as Annexure P-4.

The petitioner has been in custody since 29.09.2017. He is not required for custodial interrogation as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
