Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 26.04.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation, whereas, learned State counsel submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation but recovery has not been effected from him and the petitioner was involved in the conspiracy. Allegations of conspiracy are the matter of evidence which shall be tested during trial by the trial Court. The amount was not paid to the petitioner and hence the question of recovery of amount does not arise. Moreover, the petitioner is not the beneficiary.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 26.04.2018 passed in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
