This matter pertains to the year 1996 when the writ petition was filed *inter alia* seeking quashing of impugned order dated 11.12.1995 (Annexure P11) reversing the appellate order and upholding the order for termination of the petitioner's services pursuant to enquiry report dated 25.08.1994 (Annexure P6). Petitioner had also sought interim order on the operation and implementation of the impugned order terminating his service. However, no interim order was granted and the writ petition was admitted vide order dated 27.03.1996. When the case came up for hearing in its regular course on 13.05.2019, none appeared to represent the petitioner and in the interest of justice, this Court had issued fresh notice to the petitioner.

Office report reflects that service on the petitioner could not be effected as he has shifted from the given address.

The petitioner had been appointed as Salesman on 11.03.1987.

In view of this, it seems that relief sought by the petitioner in the writ petition is incapable of being granted as by now, he would have attained the age of superannuation and cannot be reinstated at this stage.

In the premise, writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with the liberty to the petitioner to file proper application in case any cause of action still survives.
