AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 17.07.2018 passed in bunch of writ petitions, main case being CWP No.27874 of 2017.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“Accordingly, in view of the above, the petitions are hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners in the light of Annexure P-7 within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of eight weeks thereafter. However, in case the

competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matters.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has filed reply today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. It is pleaded that order dated 24.12.2018 has been passed rejecting claim of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

The petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedies as are available in accordance with law, if aggrieved of order passed by the respondent.

The rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
