The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 327 dated 07.10.2018, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 read with Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Rajpura.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a bonafide purchaser of house measuring 58 square yards in the year 2010 for a valid consideration and the dispute is primarily civil in nature between the previous owner and the complainant. She further contends that as per the order dated 08.03.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Malwinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner has joined investigation, interim order dated 08.03.2019 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
