Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.412 dated 22.11.2018, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana, under Sections 379, 379B (2) and 473 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the secret information that the present petitioner alongwith co-accused was habitual snatcher and they used to snatch

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mobile phones etc. from the lonely persons in the locality and they were going on the stolen motor-cycle. As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner alongwith co-accused was apprehended and eight stolen mobiles and a stolen motor-cycle were recovered.

The petitioner has been in custody since 22.11.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
