This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for directing the arresting officer to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest in case FIR No.45 dated 08.06.2017 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

The allegations are that the petitioner had disappropriated paddy given to him for milling & for the past almost one year the matter has been repeatedly adjourned on the request of the counsel to enable the petitioner to settle the dispute. Even today the counsel for the petitioner prays for one more opportunity.

In my considered opinion, the petitioner is trying to play fast and loose with the Court because despite making offers to settle the dispute he has not made payment of even a single penny for the last about one year.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
