Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.57 dated 29.06.2016 registered under Sections 498-a, 406, 323, 420 of IPC at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondent No.2 in court today, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 27.02.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Nazar Singh, states that though PO proceedings were initiated against the petitioner, but

he has not been declared PO so far. He further states that pursuant to the order dated 27.02.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 27.02.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
