This writ petition was filed seeking a direction to the Chandigarh Industrial and Tourism Development Corporation Limited, the respondent herein, to grant the petitioner the pay scale of ₹2200-4000, on par with the pay scale of Chefs and Banquet Managers working in the respondent Corporation.

No interim order was granted in this writ petition.

There is no representation for the petitioner or his learned counsel when the matter is taken up for hearing. It may also be noted that when the matter was referred to the Lok Adalat for settlement in the year 2017, the petitioner did not choose to appear before the Lok Adalat. It is therefore clear that the petitioner is no longer interested in pursuing this case. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
