FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Varinder Singh in case bearing FIR No.136 dated 24.10.2018 registered at Police Station Sarbali, District Tarn Taran under Sections 498-A, 406, 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner Ms. Satwant Mehta, Advocate submits that in compliance of the orders dated 27.02.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has returned the entire Istridhan and joined the investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh, Police Station Sarhali who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the prayer in this petition is allowed.

Appreciating the arguments of the two sides, in the light of the stand of the State and the fact that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that it would be a travesty of justice to send the petitioner in custody in the present case. Accordingly, in the event of arrest, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
