Present petition has been filed with the following substantive prayers:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and direction may kindly be issued to respondents No. 2 to protect the life and property of the petitioner at the hands of the respondents No. 3 to 5 and further direct the respondent No.3 not to act as per the wishes of respondent No. 4 and 5 and not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by calling him to the police station and by interfering into his lawful possession of his land and not to unlawfully and illegally stop him from raising the construction of house in the land of his ownership, in the interest of justice.

It is further prayed that direction may kindly be issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated

9.12.2017 i.e Annexure P-2, in the interest of justice.

It is also prayed that direction may kindly be issued to respondent No. 2 and 3 to give at-least 10 days prior notice if the petitioner is required in any of the case registered at the behest of respondent No.4 and 5, in the interest of justice.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hamir Singh has submitted that civil dispute is pending between the parties and investigating agency after holding inquiry has found no substance in the complaint submitted by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, present petition is disposed of by relegating the petitioner to alternate remedies in law.
