Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the impugned order dated 27.01.2016 passed in case FIR No.134 dated 13.08.2015 registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 376(D), 120-B of IPC at Police Station Sadar, Dhuri, District Sangrur, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender.

Vide order dated 05.04.2018 while issuing notice of motion, petitioner was granted interim bail only for a period of three weeks.

At this stage, Mr. Mandeep K. Dhot, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and states that to his information, petitioner has surrendered/appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted on bail.

In view of above, present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is accordingly dismissed.

However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court and to face trial in accordance with law.
