Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Sharma, Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran submits that petitioner Vicky @ Vikramjit Singh has been declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 22.02.2019 in case bearing FIR No. 177 dated 04.09.2018 under Sections 363/366-A/120-B IPC, Section 4 of the POCSO Act and later on added offence under Section 376 IPC pertaining to Police Station Sadar Patti and in the light of the same, the present petition by proclaimed offender, prima facie, is not tenable.

At this stage, faced with the likely consequences, counsel for the petitioner has made a statement withdrawing the present petition, however, reserving the rights of the petitioner to first

challenge the order declaring the him as proclaimed offender and, thereafter, approach this Court afresh on same very grounds.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
