Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of FIR No.28 dated 20.06.2017 under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC registered at Women Police Station, Panchkula along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 21.02.2018 entered between the parties.

Vide order dated 05.04.2018 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 16.04.2018 or any other date convenient to the said Court to get their statements recorded in support of compromise. A communication dated 05.09.2018 has been received from Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Panchkula to the effect that the

parties have not appeared there for getting their statements recorded, rather, on 31.08.2018, respondent Megha Soni appeared there and stated that the opposite parties refused to appear before the Court and, therefore, it appears that no compromise has been effected between the parties.

Accordingly, fresh notices were issued by learned Magistrate to the parties for 18.09.2018.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition.

Record and conduct of the petitioners does reflect that after filing the present petition and giving unnecessary burden to the government machinery and the Court, they are enjoying at their home. Though learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition, but considering the conduct of the petitioners, the present petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn, however, subject to payment of costs of Rs.15,000/- by the petitioners to be deposited with the Bar Association of this Court. Petitioners shall deposit the same within one month from today and shall place on record copy of receipt in support of payment.
