GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J (ORAL)

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.58 dated 15.08.2018 registered at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Tarn Taran under Sections 420, 379, 506 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 26.02.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

3. Report of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Tarn Taran has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Balwinder Singh, Jodhbir Singh, Amarjit Singh and Princepal Singh (wrongly mentioned Prtipal Singh in the FIR) as well as

of complainant Tejinder Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves with the intervention of respectables and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed. The Civil Judge (Junior Division), Tarn Taran has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.58 dated 15.08.2018 registered at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Tarn Taran under Sections 420, 379, 506 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
