Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No. 5, who is trying to take forcible possession of the vehicle bearing registration number PB-02-CR-7774.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sarwan Singh, submits that with regard to grievance of the petitioner, no complaint has been received by the police and in case the petitioner moves any complaint, the same will be decided in accordance with law within a period of three months of receiving the same.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 5 submits that since the petitioner has defaulted in payment of the installments, respondent No. 5/finance company is taking action as per the hypothecation agreement.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 5 further submits that the possession of

the vehicle will be taken in accordance with law.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to approach respondent Nos. 1 and 4 by filing a fresh complaint within a period of 15 days from today and in case the petitioner files the complaint, the same will be decided by the official respondents within a period of three months thereafter.
