Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.25 dated 17.03.2018 under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 05.04.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that the petitioner is ready to take his wife back with him, but the complainant is not inclined to stay with the petitioner under the influence of her uncle who has put a condition that unless the petitioner constructs an independent house, the complainant will not accompany him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Manjit Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage and the recovery has been effected as per bills.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.04.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
