This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 25 dated 23.1.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 332, 333, 353, 186, 506 IPC at PS Chandhut, District Palwal, Haryana.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed for permission to withdraw the petition but stated that the petitioner will surrender and move an application for regular bail before the Trial Court and pray that the application be decided expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, in case the petitioner surrendered or or before 11.3.2019 and moves an application for regular bail before the Trial Court, it is directed to decide that application expeditiously on merits in any case on or before 13.3.2019.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the abovesaid observations.

Since the main case has been dismissed, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands dismissed.
