RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0001 dated 02.01.2019, registered under Sections 376, 328, 417 IPC at Women Police Station, Rewari, District Rewari.

The allegations levelled against the petitioner is that he committed rape on the prosecutrix on the pretext of marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in fact the prosecutrix wanted to marry with the petitioner and it is a case of honey trap. Thus, FIR has been lodged. He further submitted that petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2019 and trial of the case will take long time.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone

through the material available on record.

Serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner that he committed rape on the prosecutrix on the pretext of marriage. The intention of the petitioner since the beginning was unfair.

Whether it is a case of honey trap or not it shall be seen at the time of trial. Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations made against the petitioner, no case is made out to grant him regular bail.

Dismissed.
