The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.0051 dated 01.06.2016, registered under Section 509 IPC and Section 67 of the Information Technology Act, 2000, at Police Station Chabbewal, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

As per the FIR, the complainant was a teacher in government school. Someone had written obscene words regarding her on the black-board of the classroom. The said fact was brought to the notice of the head teacher, who reprimanded the students. Thereafter, she started receiving missed calls, threatening voice calls, messages and obscenes photos on the mobile.

It has been contended that the petitioner was not in India at

that time rather he was in foreign country.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 16.04.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
