This writ petition was filed seeking a direction to the respondent authorities to pay the petitioners salary on par with their counterparts working in Privately Managed Recognized Aided Schools in Chandigarh.

There is no representation for the petitioners or their learned counsel when the matter is taken up for hearing but Ms. Deepali Puri, learned counsel appearing for respondent Nos. 1 to 3, would inform this Court that as long back as on 06.05.2001, the Deputy Secretary, Education-cum-Director, Public Instruction, Chandigarh Administration, filed a sworn affidavit to the effect that the Administration was paying the petitioners salary on par with their counterparts under the grant-in-aid scheme. She would therefore state that the grievance of the petitioners stood settled

long ago.

Perhaps, that is the reason why there is no representation for the petitioners or their learned counsel when the matter is taken up for hearing today. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
