This appeal is preferred by the wife against the judgment and decree dated 10.3.2003 by which petition filed under Section 13(i)(a) & (ii) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 [for short ‘the Act’] filed by her husband was allowed.

Since the service upon the respondent could not be effected despite various opportunities, therefore, on 5.8.2004, this case was adjourned *sine die* for awaiting the appellant to provide correct address of the respondent for the purpose of service upon him.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that despite the best efforts made by the appellant correct address of the respondent is not available.

In view thereof, the present appeal is hereby dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the appellant to get it revived by recalling of the order in case the correct address of respondent is obtained.
