This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to attach the moveable and immovable property of respondent No.5 or in the alternative to decide representation dated 23.2.2018 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the police is not deliberately arresting the private respondents who are residing at their respective address and they have mobile phones which have been submitted in the representation (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to State of Punjab to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
