The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.25 dated 17.05.2018 registered for the offence under Sections 458, 380, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, the theft was committed in the premises of M/s Pooja Rice Industry at Jakhowal, where wheat bags were stored. At night time, some persons by giving beating to the security guard entered the premises and after breaking the almirah, they had stolen important documents. Thereafter, they decamped along with one truck standing there along with 348 bags of wheat. The present petitioner is nominated by the co-accused from whom the trolly and wheat bags have been recovered.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case

and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial

interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
