In the present writ petition, the prayer made by the petitioner is that though the petitioner has been dismissed from service but the petitioner has moved an application for considering his case under Clause 31 (ii) of Punjab National Bank (Employees) Pension Regulations, 1995 for the grant of compassionate allowance, which application is still pending consideration with the respondents and no final order has been passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 04.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 04.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 04.12.2018 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice

dated 04.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
