The petitioner has participated for the Group D post and is seeking direction to the respondents to give 5 marks under the socio economic criteria as he has lost his father when he was below the age of 15 years. However on a specific query put, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the mother of the petitioner is still alive. In this backdrop, the petitioner does not fall within the definition of 'orphan' and as per the individual marks displayed on the website, the petitioner has secured 40 marks under the general category (in ESP category) whereas the last selected candidate under the said category has secured 45 marks.

This petition is dismissed. However, if the petitioner gets information that anybody has been given benefit of 05 marks under the socio economic criteria when the mother is still alive, he can approach the Court again.
