The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 09 dated 23.01.2019, registered under Sections 341 and 365 of the IPC at Police Station Division A, District Amritsar.

The operative part of the order dated 27.02.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the contents of the FIR are misleading and the same have been drafted cleverly so as to involve the petitioner in a criminal case because of the fact that the brother of the petitioner has got an FIR under Section 307 IPC registered against the son of the complainant and co-accused Gagandeep Singh and has also got an FIR under Section 307 IPC registered against him. The timeline of the case supports the contention of the petitioner. The incident allegedly took place on 03.01.2019 but the complaint was filed only 04 days later on 07.01.2019. No injuries have been caused to the son of the complainant and nothing is to be recovered, therefore, the custodial interrogation of

the petitioner is not necessary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 27.02.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Balkar Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 27.02.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
