Present petition is for under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 29.11.2018 under Sections 420, 379, 411, 473, 201 of IPC, registered at Police Station Majitha Road, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 29.11.2018 and he has been falsely implicated in this case. The offence alleged against the present petitioner are triable by the Court of Magistrate. Trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more. So, he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate affirmed the period of detention and the fact that the petitioner in not involved in any other case of similar nature.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 29.11.2018 and he is not involved in any other case of similar nature. The offence alleged against the present petitioner are triable by the Court of Magistrate; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
