AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 10.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.26035 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

“In view of above, present writ petition stands disposed of with the directions to the respondents to consider and decide representation dated 09.07.2018 (Annexure P6) expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the respondents states that order of this Court could not be complied with as petitioner is not supplying the necessary details.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful will be done within two weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case details are supplied, the representation shall be considered within four weeks thereafter.

In view of statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of.

The rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
